The same can be downloaded from our website. https://prs.aicf.in/players</p> <p>The AICF has been implementing the following Rules (as part of our constitution and Bye Laws) and has been very strict in implementing the same. These Rules are posted on our website also.</p> <p>Date of Birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the child alone will be recognized and allowed to participate in age group championships by the AICF and all affiliated members of AICF.</p> <p>To help those children who have not registered their birth within one year of their birth, the Federation every year before March / April announces two days for medical test to determine their age. The above Rules have been followed very meticulously every year.</p> <p>Further, players shall present themselves for Medical Test to determine their age at any time when called upon to do so by All India Chess Federation of its affiliates. The AICF will have the powers to arrange for Medical test to determine the age of any player at any time if there is a suspicion.</p>
