RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

- **System of Play:** The championship will be played under FIDE's laws of chess and the Swiss system. Total 9 (nine) rounds will be played.
- **Default Time:** Default time for arriving to the chess board is 15 minutes.
- **Time Control:** The rate of play shall be 90 minutes with increment of 30 seconds per move from the beginning.
- **Tie Break:** In case of a tie, the latest FIDE rules shall come into effect. The cash prizes however will not be shared.
- **Appeal Committee:** Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member committee of appeal with two reserves shall be formed from amongst the senior players and officials present at the player's meet.
- **Protest:** Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1500/- within one hour of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- **Withdrawals:** No player can withdraw from the tournament without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.
- **Disqualification:** The participants disregarding the rules of the chess tournament will be disqualified.
