2. System of Play:

• The Tournament shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess for a total of 10 rounds on a Swiss-League basis.

3. Time Control:

• Each player shall have 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Prize Money Notes:

- The prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only.
- Tax will be deducted as per the Indian Income Tax Act.
- All payments to Indian players would be made by bank transfer.
- Prize winners from foreign countries would be required to submit a copy of their passport & visa.
- All GM's & Foreign players will be eligible for main category prizes only.

9. Default Time (Walkover Time):

• The default time will be 15 minutes.

10. The Drawn Game:

• The players shall not agree for a draw without consent of arbiter before each player makes 30 moves.

11. Tie-Break:

Following tie breaks will be implemented:

- a. Buchholz Cut 1.
- b. Buchholz.
- c. SB.
- d. Direct Encounter.
- e. Greater number of wins (including forfeit points)
- f. Greater number of wins with Black pieces

12. Protest:

Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.2000/- (Rs. Two thousand only) within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount would be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

13. Appeals Committee:

Appeals Committee will be formed in the technical meeting. The decision of the said committee shall be final and binding on all the participants.

14. Interpretation:

For further interpretations of the rule(s) and deciding any aspect not covered by the said tournament prospectus, the decision of the Tournament Director shall be final and binding on all the participants. The Tournament Director has every right to make any addition/deletion/amendment to these rules. However, such changes shall be displayed on the noticeboard.
