STANDINGS AND TIE BREAK:

As per latest FIDE regulations (effective from 01/08/2024), Berlin system is no longer used. Tie-breaks for team events will be as follows:

- 1. Match Points (default primary score)
- 2. Direct Encounter using Match Points
- 3. Game Points (with Unplayed Round Management)
- 4. Sonneborn Berger EMGSB (with Unplayed Round Management)
- 5. Scores and Scheduled Strength Combination (SSSC)

DEFAULT TIME:

• The default time is **15 minutes**.

APPEALS COMMITTEE:

A five-member Appeals Committee with two reserves will be formed at the technical meeting from senior participants/officials from different states. Members will recuse themselves from disputes involving their own units, and reserves will step in accordingly.

PROTESTS:

All protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, along with a protest fee of Rs. 1,000/-. The fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld. The Appeals Committee's decision will be final and binding.
