<b>System of Play:</b>	<b>The Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with 9 Rounds. All players will be playing together</b>
<b>Reporting Time:</b>	<b>All players should Report at 8.30 am. Tournament will start at 9.00 am.</b>
<b>Time Control:</b>	<b>15 Minutes + 5 Seconds increment from move one for the entire game.</b>
<b>Tie Break:</b>	<b>1. Buchholz Cut-1, 2. Buchholz, 3. SB 4. Direct Encounter, 5. Greater Number of wins (forfeit included), 6. Greater number of wins with black.</b>
<b>AICF Registration:</b>	<b>Valid AICF ID required before the start of the first round</b>
<b>MCA Registration:</b>	<b>For all Maharashtra players a valid MCA ID is required before the start of the first round</b>

<b>Appeals Committee:</b>	<b>A 5-member Appeals Committee (with 2 reserve) will be formed during the Players' meeting before the start of event.</b>

**Tarabai Shinde (1850–1910) was a feminist activist who protested patriarchy and caste in 19th century India. She is known for her published work, Stri Purush Tulana (“A Comparison Between Women and Men”), originally published in Marathi in 1882. The pamphlet is a critique of caste and patriarchy and is often considered the first modern Indian feminist text. It was very controversial for its time in challenging the Hindu religious scriptures themselves as a source of women’s oppression, a view that continues to be controversial and debated today. She was a member of Satyashodhak Samaj.**
