General Information & Rules

- ❖ Eligiblity: The tournament is open for all players who have not crossed the Standard FIDE rating of 1800 in the past 36 months prior to the start of the tournament are eligible to participate.
- System of Play: The tournament shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess for a total of 9 rounds on a Swiss-League basis.
- **★** <u>Time Control:</u> Each player shall have 60 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.
- **❖** <u>Fair Play:</u> Players who finished first or second in any rating restricted tournament will not be eligible to play in any rating restricted tournament for one year from the date of such achievement

Prize Money Notes:

- ✓ The prizes shall not be shared and a player would be eligible for one higher prize only.
- ✓ Tax will be deducted as per the Indian Income Tax Act.
- ✓ All payments to Indian players would be made by bank transfer.
- ✓ Prize winners from foreign countries would be required to submit a copy of their passport & visa.

- ❖ <u>Protest:</u> Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.2000/- (Rs. Two thousand only) within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount would be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- Organiser reserves the right to accept or reject any entries without assigning any reason.

1. Appeals Committee:

Appeals Committee will be formed in the technical meeting. The decision of the said committee shall be final and binding on all the participants.

2. <u>Interpretation</u>:

For further interpretations of the rule(s) and deciding any aspect not covered by the said tournament prospectus, the decision of the Tournament Director shall be final and binding on all the participants. The Tournament Director has every right to make any addition/deletion/amendment to these rules.
