Rules & Regulations

The tournament is open to all eligible players.

The event shall be conducted as a 9-Round Swiss System Rapid Tournament.

Pairings will be generated using Swiss-Manager pairing software.

The tournament shall be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess and all applicable FIDE regulations.

Time Control

25 minutes + 10 seconds increment per move, starting from Move 1.

Tie-Break System

In the event of a tie in the final standings, the following tie-break criteria shall be applied in the order listed below:

Buchholz Cut 1

Buchholz

Sonneborn-Berger

Direct Encounter

Greater Number of Wins

Greater Number of Wins with Black Pieces

Electronic Devices

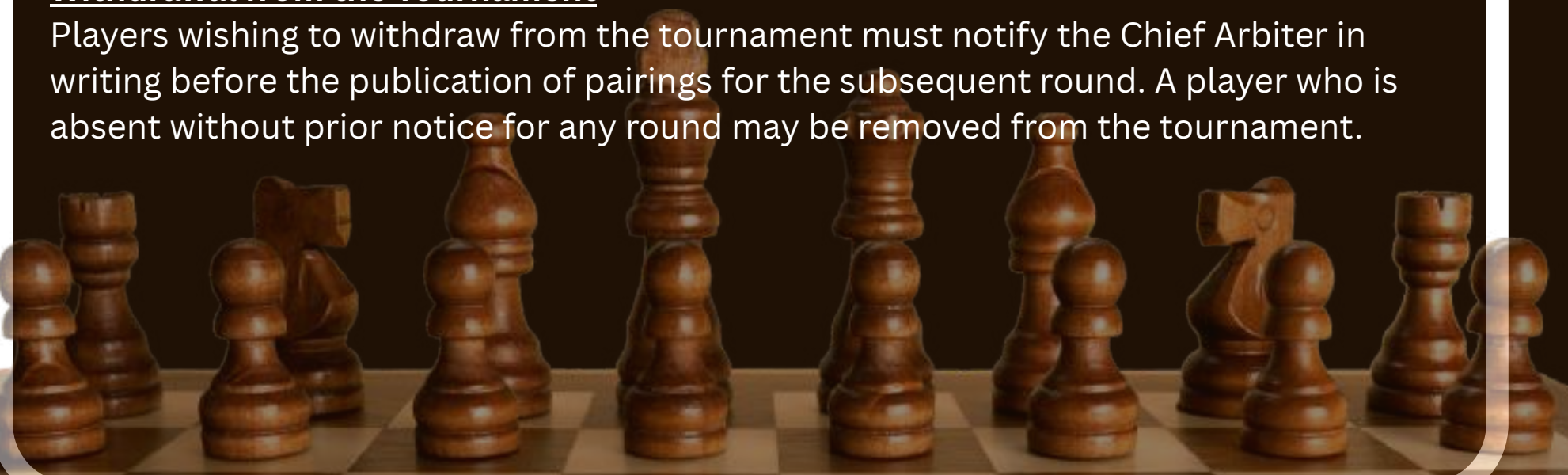
Players shall not possess or use mobile phones, smartwatches, or any electronic communication devices within the playing venue unless specifically permitted by the Chief Arbiter in accordance with FIDE regulations.

Fair Play

The tournament shall strictly adhere to the FIDE Fair Play Regulations. Anti-cheating measures may include screening, monitoring, and other procedures deemed necessary by the Organizing Committee and Chief Arbiter.

Withdrawal from the Tournament

Players wishing to withdraw from the tournament must notify the Chief Arbiter in writing before the publication of pairings for the subsequent round. A player who is absent without prior notice for any round may be removed from the tournament.



Authority of the Chief Arbiter

The Chief Arbiter shall have the authority to interpret these regulations and make decisions on matters not specifically covered herein, in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess. The Chief Arbiter's decisions during the course of the tournament shall be final, subject to appeal where applicable.

Appeals

Any appeal against a decision of an Arbiter or the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Committee within 10 minutes of the completion of the game, accompanied by an appeal fee of ₹2,000. The fee shall be refunded only if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee

An Appeals Committee comprising three members shall be constituted prior to the commencement of Round 1. The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding on all participants.

Broadcasting Rights

The Organizers reserve the exclusive rights to photograph, record, live-stream, broadcast, publish, and reproduce the tournament in any media format. Participation in the tournament shall constitute the player's consent to the use of their name, image, likeness, and games for promotional, educational, and broadcasting purposes without additional compensation.

Code of Conduct

All players, officials, coaches, parents, and spectators are expected to maintain the highest standards of sportsmanship and discipline throughout the event. Any act of cheating, misconduct, disruption, abusive behaviour, or violation of tournament regulations may result in penalties, forfeiture, expulsion from the venue, or disqualification from the tournament.
