PRIZE ELIGIBILITY

- Girl players will be eligible for Girls prize and selection only.
- Boys players will be eligible for Open prize and selection only.
- Girl players can however choose to compete for Open category prize and selection, they should notify the Chief Arbiter in writing before the start of Round 1.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 System of Play** — The Championship will be conducted as per FIDE Rules & Regulations.
- 2 Time Control** — 60 minutes each with increment of 30 seconds from move number one.
- 3 Default Time** — Default time will be 15 minutes.
- 4 Tie Break** — Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct encounter. The greater number of wins (forfeit included). The greater number of wins by black.
- 5 In case of tie, cash prizes will not be shared.**
- 6 Electronic Devices** — All electronic devices like Mobile phone, Bluetooth etc. including wristwatches (all types of watches) and bags are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- 7 Protest** — Protest, if any is against the decision of Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with protest fee of Rs. 2,000/- within 15 minutes of occurrence of the incidence. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- 8 Appeals Committee** — Three members + Two reserves appeal committee shall be formed. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player himself is involved; in such cases, the reserve can take his place in the committee.
- 9 Disqualification** — No participant will leave the tournament venue before the prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter, otherwise his/her prize and certificate will be forfeited and disciplinary action will be taken.
