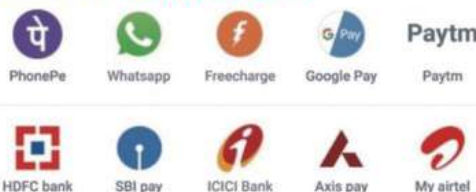

TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1



SYSTEM OF PLAY

The Championship will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess & FIDE Swiss system in 09 rounds with time control **25 minutes + 10 seconds** increment from move one.

2



DEFAULT TIME

The default time for arriving to the chessboard is **25 minutes** or flag fall.

3



ELECTRONIC DEVICES

All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are **not allowed** in the tournament hall.

4



TIE-BREAK

Following is the order of tie-break:

- (a) Buchholz Cut1 (b) Buchholz (c) Sonneborn Berger
(d) Direct encounter (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included).

PROTEST

Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a Protest fee of **Rs. 1000/-** within **30 minutes** of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded, if the appeal is upheld.

6



DISQUALIFICATION

No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

7



AICF REGISTRATION

All participants in the Tournament should be registered with AICF for the year **2026-27**.

APPEALS COMMITTEE

Before the commencement of the championship, a five Member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from the different units. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own State is involved and in such case the reserves shall take his place in the committee.

INTERPRETATION & AMENDMENTS

On any point not covered under these rules, the decision of the Championship Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Championship Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without prior notice. However, such changes will be approved by the MP Chess Ad-hoc Committee. Such changes will, However be displayed in the tournament hall.
